Recently, the Farabundo Martí Front for National Liberation (FLNM) and the FDR made a new proposal for peace in El Salvador. The Salvadoran government rejected this proposal, although President Duarte said that he had "high hopes" of finding political avenues to a peopletated of finding political avenues to a negotiated solution.

hopes'" of finding political avenues to a negotiated solution.

Ungo, however, "For President Duarte the dialogue is a game of illusions which gives him and the armed forces the opportunity to continue their effort to secure a military solution for the situation of our country". He stated that for the people in power in El Salvador, dialogue is a tactical and not a strategic option and their objective is not really to find a peaceful solution, but to gain support and political space in which to make it possible to prolong the war.

For the FMLN/FDR, on the contrary, dialogue is a tactical and a strategic option: tactic, "because it allows them to gain political space, and strategic, because dialogue is the only national option in the present political process". He also said that in the short term, he has very little optimism, but in the medium and long term, he is highly optimistic.

"It is important to remember that since 1980, the FMLN/FDR decided to raise the objective of a negotiated political solution as its political constant. Today, other sectors are supporting this policy and they are pressing for a point where mutual interests can be met, for a basic program which might enable such a solution".

Several Salvadoran political sectors, consulted by INFORPEACE, said it is absolutely necessary to make the conflict more humane and to relieve the burden of non-combatant Salvadorans. The National burden of non-combatant Salvadorans. The National Conciliation Party considers that the next elections have to bring about a consensus that requires the next government to find a peaceful solution. These up coming elections have to be evaluated as "a historic fact which may bring about a political solution and not a military one".

In this sense, Guillermo Ungo stated that the FMLN/FDR considers the establishment of a government made up of the nation's different political powers and based on the development of a successful joint program of action one of its possible objectives.
