Your Authorised Apple Dealer will be glad to advise you on making your connection.

Upon subscribing you'll receive a letter welcoming you and details of how to connect to *Apple Concourse*. You'll also receive your password and your 'ID' – the name you'll be known as on *Apple Concourse*.

Payment is easy: all payments are made by Visa or Access with the monthly connection charges being automatically debited from your credit card account.
