Grant Proposal to MacArthur Foundation 16 June 1988

Objective:

"To provide to the Environment and Peace Movements an international communications capability as good as that available to the governments, and multi-national commercial enterprises."

Summary

This grant proposal is for a general purpose grant to help put GreenNet on a sound financial footing and to provide it with some of the resources it needs to take it through the next year. GreenNet expects to achieve break-even in a year but needs top-up funding this year in order to be able to provide the resources being requested by its expanding user-base and to enable it to participate in the international expansion program detailed below.
