- apc.scripts** — Contains scripts and macros for use with the IGC and other APC Networks and discussion about their use.
- conf.manager** — Primarily for conference facilitators and network staff, a public conference announcing topic deletions and other inter-APC conference networking information.
- conferences** — Contains a list of conferences by category, with brief descriptions of each.
- documentation** — Contains online versions (both text and binary) of the IGC User Manual.
- facilitators** — Help for conference facilitators, including instructions on creating a conference.
- gateways** — Contains instructions for sending email to other computer networks, fax and telex. One topic per network.
- gen.references** — Reviews of readers' favorite book, video, magazine or other media item.
- help** — Contains frequently asked questions on how to use the Network. Must use the (g)o command to access this conference.
- ideas** — Your proposals for developing the networks, including proposals for new conferences.
- intlaccess** — Contains information on how to access the Networks from specific countries (one country per topic).
- micro** — Contains software- or hardware-specific questions and their answers. Go here if you are having trouble with a particular aspect of your computer.
- netnews** — News about the APC networks and developments within. Contains the quarterly IGC NetNews newsletter.
- oz.ideas** — Ideas for new conferences and anything else new but basically Australia-specific are welcome. Use the international 'ideas' conference for ideas pertaining to software changes or conference proposals of global interest.
- standard** — Contains standard answers to the most common questions received by Network staff.
- test** — Conference to be used for practice and experimentation.
- welcome** — A conference welcoming you to the network, and providing tips for newcomers.

<b>geo2.latinamer</b>	— Imported from GeoNet covering a wide range of Latin America issues. Read only.
<b>info.elsalvado</b>	— Information in Spanish, English and French focusing on El Salvador.
<b>ni.centam-elec</b>	— Information about electoral processes in Central America.
<b>ni.elec-centro</b>	— Spanish-language version of 'ni.centam-elec' - information from primary and secondary sources in the Central American region about 1991 elections. Topics from September 1990 to February 1991 only.
<b>ni.noticias</b>	— In Spanish and English, announcements of events in, general information on, or observations about Nicaragua.
<b>nicalelec.canad</b>	— Committee for Peace & Democracy - a Canadian-founded coalition working in Nicaragua to monitor the electoral process from a Canadian perspective

<b>dev.humansettl</b>	— Information concerning human settlements, encompassing all the structures and processes associated with the human habitat. Focus will be on presenting items that deal with the problems of the world's cities, towns and villages.
<b>en.urban</b>	— Environmental issues concerning towns & cities.
<b>geo2.coops</b>	— News and information exchange on workers cooperatives, from Poptel in London. Read only.
<b>gn.communities</b>	— Provides a forum for people who live in or are interested in communities, here defined as a group of people living together out of choice and the belief that the collective is more important than the individual.
<b>gn.ecotopia</b>	— A preliminary online brainstorming about the themes of the festival ECOTOPIA 89 held in Köln, August 1989, and planned for annual occurrence in the future.
<b>gn.findhorn</b>	— Topics of interest to members of the Findhorn Foundation and its extended family and friends.
<b>peb.population</b>	— This conference concentrates on overpopulation in the U.S. & ways that is exacerbating global warming, overdevelopment, air pollution, waste disposal, educational systems, etc. For anyone with concern who is interested in learning more
