



The San Francisco/Moscow Teleport, Inc. (SFMT) has


entered into a five-year agreement with the USSR's Institute for Automated Systems (IAS) to provide electronic mail (E-Mail) services between the United States and the Soviet Union.

SFMT E-Mail allows you to communicate instantly with colleagues across the ocean over the first direct satellite link between the US and the USSR. The only equipment you need is your personal computer, modem, and communications software.

Gateway Services

SFMT E-Mail can interconnect with a variety of other E-Mail

systems. In addition, gateway services are available to send and receive telex messages or to forward your E-Mail messages to fax machines in over 100 countries.

You can easily connect to SFMT E-Mail by dialing a local tele-

phone access number through your public telephone network.



Getting Started

In order to communicate with the USSR, you must first secure an

agreement with a counterpart in the Soviet Union for an SFMT E-Mail connection. If your colleague is currently using SFMT E-Mail, you can begin communicating within 2 days after we receive your signed service agreement and your one-time set-up fee. If your Soviet colleague is not yet an SFMT E-Mail user, a three-to five-week period is generally required for necessary contractual arrangements in the USSR.

In some cases, you may wish to expedite communications by providing your Soviet counterpart with a PC and an error-correcting modem. SFMT can assist you in selecting and obtaining the necessary equipment.



Online Translation Services

Messages can be translated online using SFMT's professional

translators, with expertise in business, legal, scientific, and technical translation. English-to-Russian and Russian-to-English translation services are available.



Customer Support Services

You will be provided with an SFMT E-Mail User Manual and

the technical support needed to connect with and use our electronic mail services. Whenever you need assistance, customer support is readily available online, or you can call our offices in San Francisco or Moscow during business hours. In addition, users of our Enhanced Service can obtain special training and technical support in Moscow as well as assistance in following up unaswered messages. Consulting services are also available on a project-by-project basis.



Hours of Availability

Users in the United States can access SFMT E-Mail 24 hours per

day, seven days a week. Soviet-based users can access the system 24 hours per day, except from 3:00 pm Saturday through 9:00 am Monday (Moscow time) and on seven major Soviet holidays.



Security

You will be provided with a personal system ID and a

private password so that other users cannot access your correspondence.
